

Guideline procedures for concerns about possible poor practice, or breaches of Archery GB Policies, Law, Rules, Guidelines or Codes of Conduct at Reigate Priory Bowmen.

You become aware of a possible poor practice concern or possible breach of Archery GB Policy, Laws, Rules, Guidelines or Code of Conduct.

Where possible, concerns should be resolved at club level. Please report your concerns to the Club Safeguarding Officer.



If the Safeguarding Officer has exhausted all options at Club Level, and the concern cannot be resolved; it should be referred up to the next level (County Association and then Regional Society).



If the concern cannot be resolved at the County or Regional levels, the Regional Official must refer the concern to the Archery GB Safeguarding Officer. They will then refer the matter to the Archery GB Case Management Panel (CMP).



Possible outcomes:

- Concern referred to Region with CMP recommendations
- A request for further information
- Training or further training required
- Supervision and/or monitoring required
- Advise/warning given about future conduct
- No case to answer
- Referral to an Archery GB Disciplinary Panel. Following a decision from the panel, there may be a referral to an Appeal Panel.

All allegations of this nature are sensitive and should be discussed on a "need to know" basis. Confidentiality must be maintained until the outcome of any investigation is released.
